Dear P1 Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to term 4!

We hope you have had a short yet enriching break with your child. With the option of mask off in school, we will continue to provide more opportunities for our students - fostering a sense of **P**urpose and enhancing **E**ngagement. (PROSPER Framework)

Students have a sense of 'purpose' when they perceive that their goals are worthwhile. Having a sense of purpose is closely related to a sense of meaning in life and frequently involves a pro-social or altruistic intent such as a commitment to helping others or improving the world.

Our students had participated activities like adopting an area in the school to take care, making appreciating cards for our Non-Teaching Staff and donating food for the needy in our community. Another example of empowering students by giving them a 'voice', autonomy and sense of purpose is through their participation in Focus Group Discussions. Through these discussions, students voiced out their perspectives on teachers, student leaders and learning experiences in the school.

All these *Engagement* have allowed our students to be more actively engaged and involved in each step and task in the learning process and their critical and creative thinking.

As our students move on to the next level of their education pathways, they may struggle to make sense of their existence, parents can also play a pivotal role by engaging them in thought-provoking discussions, asking relevant questions, and helping them in self-directed learning, thus, finding a meaningful and helpful purpose in this modern world.

Home-Based Learning (HBL)

Do take note that on **Monday 26 September**, the **P1** cohort will not report to school. Instead, they will do Home-Based Learning. Your child's Form Teacher and Mother Tongue Teacher will inform you of the HBL tasks for each subject via Parent Gateway.

Level Induction Programme 2023

The Level Induction Program will be held on the first two days of the academic year 2023 and aims to induct our students into their new levels. Returning students would have to cope with not only a new environment, but new teachers and new classmates as well. During the course of the programme, class rules, routines & procedures would be established and their rationale explained. The induction programme serves to establish the standards in what is acceptable and unacceptable, appropriate and inappropriate, the importance of regular attendance, punctuality, as well as, introduce students to the common approaches to positive discipline and the support systems put in place to cater to the students' diverse needs.

The programme will also introduce to the students to the objectives and expectations of some level specific programmes such as Programme for Active Learning, amongst others. It also aims to induct the students into the Formal Curriculum (English, Mathematics, Science, Mother Tongue, Character and Citizen Education, Information and Communication Technology, Physical and Health Education, Aesthetics and Co-Curricular Activities), as well as provide some time for teacher student interaction.
